### 2023 Sustainability Champion Award

The Sustainability Champion Award is designed to recognize individuals or teams that deliver both short-term and long-term solutions that provide documented social, environmental, and economic value and results. Sustainability reflects both a mindset and a value set and these individuals/teams freely share their passion, wisdom, and dedication to their work. A Sustainability Champion embraces the possibilities of change and integrates principles of sustainability into day-to-day business operations. The Sustainability Champion Award is designed to recognize the vision and commitment of individuals and/or teams that often go unrecognized.

## The Sustainability Champion award will go to an individual who:

- Creates systems that integrate sustainability, for example, develops metrics, policies, or processes
- Works to generate buy-in and align sustainability with corporate culture

- Engages stakeholders on sustainability through multiple channels, recognizing and celebrating successes
- Creates opportunities for leadership and/or innovation in others or departments
- Makes sustainability personal and perhaps contributes to their community in a meaningful way
- Goes above and beyond, whether sustainability is their job title or not

#### **Award Eligibility & Instructions:**

- The business has its headquarters or operations in Wisconsin
- The business the champion works for is a current WSBC member. (A discount is offered to those applying for membership at the time of nomination)
- The individual has not won an award from us within the last three years
- Self-nominations are normal and encouraged
- When nominating a champion, please fill out the questions to the best of your ability. The more detailed applications tend to score better by the committee.
- Applications should include identification and, if possible, quantification of direct and indirect impacts of the individual.
- There is the ability to upload supplemental data and links at the end.

\*We are now accepting video nominations. This is optional and does not replace the nomination form entirely. Please keep videos to 2 minutes in length and answer the same questions as the nomination form. Please also include any supplemental documentation about the nominee that would be helpful.

To submit the video nomination, there is a place at the end of this form to upload your video or provide a link to your video. Still fill out basic information and any relevant questions.
