These individuals generously share their passion, insights, and commitment to their work, earning recognition as influencers in their spheres of influence.

The Sustainable Leadership Awards pay tribute to individuals who champion business practices that serve all stakeholders, from shareholders to employees, customers, and community members. They exhibit an exceptional dedication to sustainable business approaches, serving as examples for others to emulate.

The Executive Leader Award will be given to an individual who:

- Embodies visionary leadership, fostering a comprehensive approach to steering organizational culture toward sustainability.
- Empowers sustainable decision-making and fosters innovation across the organization, demonstrating tangible social and/or environmental benefits for customers and communities.
- Articulates a clear message on sustainability and champions their teams, acknowledging and celebrating achievements.
- Recognizes the significance of educating stakeholders on sustainability and takes proactive steps to do so.

- Demonstrates consistent commitment and philanthropy, giving back to the community in impactful ways.
- Advocates for organizational alignment with local and/or global sustainability initiatives, such as the Sustainable Development Goals, Green Masters' Program, B Corporation, We're Still In, etc.
- Establishes a personal connection with sustainability.

Award Eligibility

- The business has a presence in Wisconsin.
- The business leader or team is a current WSBC member (or the company they work for).
- The individual has not won an award from us within the last three years in this product category.
- Self-nominations are normal and encouraged.
- When nominating, please fill out the questions to the best of your ability. The more detailed applications tend to be scored better by the committee.
- Applications should include identification and, if possible, quantification of direct and indirect impacts of the individual.
- There is the ability to upload supplemental data and links at the end.




