SUSTAINABLE BUSINESS AWARDS

The Sustainable Business Awards recognize businesses and individuals that are prioritizing sustainability and making strides toward impactful change in Wisconsin. The winners of these awards demonstrate leadership, initiative, and innovation and are making measurable impacts. The Sustainable Business Awards celebrate recipients for challenging conventional business practices and demonstrating cutting-edge environmental, social, and governance leadership while rewarding them for being leaders in their industry and community.

2023 Sustainable Product Award

Through product design or redesign, companies can make substantial triple bottom-line improvements for their company and user. Environmental or social impact comes from the use or making of products. The Sustainable Product Award will be given to individuals, teams, or companies for designing, or redesigning, a product with sustainability top of mind.

The sustainable product nominee must demonstrate they achieve one or more of the following results in the manufacturing or the end use of their product:

- Increased energy, material, and/or water efficiency
- Reduced emissions or waste during use
- Reduced embodied energy, which is the total energy used in the making of the product, plus the energy necessary for the product's life cycle

- Changed the product material to something more sustainable to achieve the same, or better outcome(s)
- Extended the product life so it doesn't have to be repaired or replaced as frequently
- Designed for end-of-life or circularity (designed so that the parts and pieces can be repurposed rather than discarded at the end of use)
- Designed to increase worker and/or community safety and health

Award Eligibility

- The business has its headquarters or operations in Wisconsin
- The business is a current WSBC member
- The product you are nominating is within the company's Wisconsin operations
- The company has not won an award from us within the last three years within this product category
- Businesses and individuals are encouraged to self-nominate or nominate another business, team or individual
- Applications need to include identification and, if possible, quantification of direct and indirect impacts of the product
- The product must be in the market before applying. You can also apply for more than one award category per company.

***We are now accepting video nominations.** This is optional and does not replace the nomination form entirely. Please keep videos to 2 minutes in length and answer the same questions as the nomination form. Please also include any supplemental documentation about the nominee that would be helpful.

To submit the video nomination, there is a place at the end of this form to upload your video or provide a link to your video. Still fill out basic information and any relevant questions.
